We've made some great changes to the registration process that will make it much easier to get your child(ren) signed up and paid for so your program coordinator can focus on the many responsibilities that come with bringing this all together. Don't forget to thank your coordinator because they put in a lot of time and effort long before your child arrives for the first week of the program.

So here's the deal on what's new, and there's lots so be sure to read it all. You will be signing your child(ren) up on the Gunstock website at [www.gunstock.com](http://www.gunstock.com). It is there that you will be paying for the cost of the program at Gunstock as well as filling out and printing all the necessary waivers that go along with participating in the program and renting equipment, if needed. Please pay close attention to the deadline dates for the online sign-up as well as handing in your printed waiver forms to your outreach coordinator. There will be late fee for all sign-ups past the due date so be sure to mark your calendars, or better yet, go online today and register so you can check it off your to-do-list.

Please log in, read each document thoroughly, fill out the necessary waivers, print and sign them, and complete the payment portion of the online registration. The waivers should be signed by a parent or guardian and returned to your coordinator by the deadline before considering your child(ren) enrolled in the program. Online payment only, **does not** hold your spot in the group. The signed waivers returned to your coordinator are also a very necessary part of the registration process.



This year each student will be issued a pass with their name and school or group name on it. This pass will be valid **only** for the days of your child's program. This pass **must** be attached to their jacket or snow pants each and every week. If your child loses or forgets their pass, they will need to purchase a \$10 replacement in order to participate that with their school or group that day/night. No exceptions! The new pass is an exciting addition to the program and will save valuable time each week by not having to hand out lift tickets once at the mountain. These passes are non-transferable and no one should ever use the pass other than the person it is purchased for.

More exciting news! Have you heard about our new Flex Pass? If not, listen up because this is a deal you won't want to miss. Available to any outreach participant and their immediate family is a \$25 Flex Pass (normally priced at \$50) that allows the Flex Pass holder to purchase regularly priced Primetime or Night lift tickets for half price, any day of the week. In other words, you could purchase a \$25 Flex Pass for your child(ren) and yourself so you can all ski or ride at half price all season. The outreach participant will use their outreach pass on the days of their school/group program but can use their Flex Pass on all other days they want to ski or ride with family or friends. Each person will need their own Flex Pass as these are non-transferable and only valid for the person listed on the pass. This is the perfect choice for parents or siblings who want to ski or ride while your child is here with their school or group. You will have a chance to purchase the Flex Pass when you go in to register your child(ren) for the outreach program. Remember, this deal is only for the immediate families of the outreach participant.

\*If conditions are not appropriate for cross country or snowshoeing at Gunstock we will provide an alternate program for the same fee. Alternate programs include: nature hikes, scavenger hunts and "where animals go in the winter".

**Outreach chaperones must be working with or on behalf of the school / group or recreation dept. The Outreach coordinator for each group will be responsible for supplying a roster and waivers for each person that will be chaperoning on a weekly or rotating basis.**

**NEW THIS YEAR:** Any outreach participant and their immediate family are eligible to purchase a \$25 Flex Pass (normally priced at \$50). A Flex Pass allows the pass holder to purchase regularly priced Primetime or Night lift tickets for half price, any day of the week all season long. The outreach participant will use their outreach pass on the days of their school/group program but can use their Flex Pass on all other days they want to ski or ride with family or friends. Each individual needs their own Flex Pass as these are non-transferable and only valid for the person listed on the pass. This is the perfect choice for parents or siblings who want to ski or ride while your child is here with their school or group. You will have a chance to purchase the Flex Pass when you go in to register your child(ren) for the outreach program. Remember, this discounted rate of \$25 is only for the immediate families of the outreach participant.

## FLEX PASS

**NEW THIS YEAR:** Available to any Outreach participant and their immediate family members is a \$25 Flex Pass (normally priced at \$50) per person. A Flex Pass allows the individual card holder to purchase any regularly priced Primetime or Night lift tickets for **half price**, any day of the week - ALL SEASON LONG. Flex Passes are **NON-TRANSFERABLE**.

The outreach participant will use their outreach pass on the days of their scheduled school/group program but can use their Flex Pass for all other days. Flex Passes are the perfect choice for parents or siblings who want to ski or ride while your child is at Gunstock with their school or group. Parents will have a chance to purchase the Flex Pass when they log in to register their child(ren) for the outreach program. Remember, this discounted rate is only for the immediate families of the outreach participant.

## Outreach Parents FAQ's

**1. How is the cost of the program broken down?**

The program has two costs associated with it. The lift/lesson ticket for each student costs \$25/week for Belknap County school districts and \$28/week for schools in other counties. The rental fees are \$25/week for either skis or snowboard and a helmet rental. The school or recreation department may add additional fees for the cost of transportation, but this is **not** a fee added by Gunstock.

**2. What if a child or chaperone misplaces or forgets to bring their Outreach pass for a scheduled visit?**

This year each student will be issued a pass with their name and school or group name on it. This pass will be valid **only** for the days of your child's program. **This pass must be attached to their jacket or snow pants each and every week. If your child loses or forgets their pass, they will need to purchase a \$10 replacement in order to participate that with their school or group that day/night. No exceptions!** The new pass is an exciting addition to the program and will save valuable time each week by not having to hand out lift tickets once at the mountain. These passes are non-transferable and no one should ever use the pass other than the person it is purchased for.

**3. If there is a possibility that my child may receive ski or snowboard equipment as a gift, should I sign them up for rentals?**

**NO!** If there is a chance your child will receive equipment before the program begins **DO NOT sign them up for rentals.** If they end up not receiving the equipment, then you may add the rental and pay for it separately. This change must take place prior to the program start date. The addition of rental equipment goes through your group's outreach coordinator. **DO NOT** call Gunstock directly to add this for your child, please notify your Outreach coordinator.

**4. How do I go about getting a refund if my child gets equipment and I have already paid for rentals through Gunstock?**

You must submit a refund request form through your group's outreach coordinator. The coordinator has the appropriate form and they will send it to Gunstock for your refund. The refund will be issued at the end of April when all accounting for outreach is completed.

**5. What if my child has a season pass to Gunstock?**

The program costs the same for each student regardless if they have a season pass. The rate is specific to the Outreach program and is discounted from our normal group lesson rate of \$45.

**6. What if my child does not want to take the lesson?**

Gunstock highly recommends that every student participate in the lessons offered. However, it is only mandatory if your school or recreation department has a policy that each student must participate in the lesson group. You **must** follow the policy of your school or recreation department. The cost of the program **does not** change if the student chooses not to participate in the lesson with the approval of your coordinator.

**7. What if my child has an injury or illness and cannot continue to participate in the program?**

If your child should get injured or become ill and cannot complete the remainder of the program due to health issues (withdrawing completely), Gunstock will gladly issue a refund for the remaining weeks of the program.

- You must provide a doctor's note stating the date of the injury or illness and complete a refund request form.
- The documents should be given to your group's coordinator who will submit them to Gunstock. Submission should take place within 10 days of the injury or illness.
- Gunstock will process refunds at the end of April.

**8. What if my child is ill and cannot participate for a given week during the program? Will they be entitled to a refund?**

A refund is only issued if the injury or illness prevents the child from participating in the remainder of the program and is documented by a Physician.

- We do not issue refunds for short term illnesses such as the flu or a cold, or for other conflicts that may arise outside of the program.

**9. What if I forget to submit a refund request for my child? Can I do so once the program ends?**

All refunds must be submitted within 10 days of the date of the injury or illness. Rental refunds must be submitted prior to the program starting. No refunds will be issued outside of these time frames.

**10. What if my child feels that the lesson group they are in is not appropriate for their level and ability?**

Any concerns relating to the lesson level for your child should be brought to your group coordinator's attention. Please understand that it is the final word of Gunstock's instructors as to the appropriate level for each student.

**10. What if my child wants to switch from skiing to snowboarding or vice versa each week?**

Your child may switch one time immediately following the first week of the program. No exceptions to this after the second week.

**11. What happens during inclement weather?**

At Gunstock, we love winter weather! However, your group's coordinator may determine that it is best to cancel on a particular day and schedule a make-up session later in the season. If the group cancels, lift/lesson passes will NOT be available to any individuals in the program on that day.

**12. If I have any questions about the program who should I contact?**

Please direct all questions or concerns through the Outreach coordinator for your group.

# MOVEMENT PATTERNS AND CHARACTERISTICS OF

## SNOWBOARDERS BY LEVEL

**First Timers:** Never snowboarded at a mountain before

### **Mountain Magic:**

Snowboards Green terrain on Magic Carpet and/or Penny Complex.

- Can put on and take off snowboard binding properly.
- Knows how to tie boots properly.
- Comfortable skating, gliding, navigating, and stopping with one foot strapped in the board at the bottom of the mountain (base area).
- Can load and unload chairlift properly and safely
- Able to turn to a stop on heel and toe side.
- Turns are choppy and riders prefer one turn to the other (heel or toe).
- Can do falling leaf comfortably.
- Willing to learn
- Knows Snowboarder's Responsibility Code

### **Mountain Adventure:**

Rides all Green terrain. Snowboards most Blue terrain depending on snow conditions.

- Demonstrates S-turns on blue and green terrain.
- Able to perform skidded turns in both directions
- Can link turns of varying size at moderate speeds.
- Riders are starting to skid less, with the tail of the board following the tip, for more control of their line.
- Understands direction change will control speed.
- Starting to demonstrate carve turns.
- Motivated to learn more
- Starting to use Snowboarder's Responsibility Code

### **Mountain Excitement:**

Rides all Blue and Green terrain in all snow conditions. Snowboards most black terrain in difficult snow conditions.

- Turns are rhythmical and flow with consistency.
- Can carve all turns and uses a skidded turns as a functional tool only, e.g. unloading from a chairlift, entering a chairlift line.
- Starting to be comfortable in riding moguls, freestyle moves, and various snow conditions.
- Have specific skills they would like to improve.
- Uses Snowboarder's Responsibility Code.

# MOVEMENT PATTERNS AND CHARACTERISTICS OF ALPINE SKIERS BY LEVEL

**First Time** - Never skied before

## **Mountain Magic**

Skis Green terrain on Magic Carpet and/or Penny Complex.

- Can put on and take off skis.
- Can walk, side step and herringbone.
- Can stop by turning or increasing size of Wedge.
- Demonstrates slight changes in direction.
- Direction changes show little rhythm, flow or consistency.
- Shows little knowledge of turn shape to control speed.
- Can load/unload chair safely. If on carpet shows movement patterns that will soon allow introduction to chair riding.
- Shows willingness to learn.
- Knows Skier's Responsibility Code

## **Mountain Adventure**

Skis all Green terrain. Skis most Blue terrain depending on snow conditions.

- Glides with skis in a parallel position or small Wedge.
- Can stop by turning or with a hockey stop.
- Demonstrates turns which are "Z" shaped and/or somewhat round.
- Turns are starting to show rhythm, flow but lack consistency.
- Shows knowledge that direction changes control speed.
- Beginning to explore different turn shapes, terrain variations, freestyle moves, difficult snow conditions and racing.
- Shows desire to learn more.
- Knows Skier's Responsibility Code and uses it with a little coaching.

## **Mountain Excitement**

Skis all Blue terrain in all snow conditions. Skis all Black groomed terrain. Skis most Black terrain in difficult snow conditions.

- Glides with skis in a parallel position. Wedge is used only as a functional tool, e.g. in a lift line, turning in tight places, etc.
- Can stop with a hockey stop on command.
- Demonstrates turns which are round.
- Turns show rhythm and flow with consistency.
- Understands that turns are meant to change direction which by default controls speed. In other words, turns don't control speed - direction changes control speed. Totally different mindset - offensive vs defensive movement patterns.
- Can demonstrate different turn shapes at varying speeds.
- Becoming very proficient at skiing bumps, difficult snow conditions, freestyle moves and racing.
- Can load/unload all chairs safely and explain/demonstrate how to do so.
- Embraces the need for continual exploring/learning.
- Knows Skier's Responsibility Code and uses it consistently every run.

**WARNING:** All forms of skiing, snowboarding, recreational activities and the use of aerial and surface lifts are hazardous. Falls and injuries are a common occurrence. Recreational users of the ski area must use deliberate and conscious control and proper equipment, both on the ground and in the air, in relation to ever changing variables and dangers. Safety is directly affected by personal judgment in the severe elements of mountain forest terrain. Ski and/or ride within one's own ability. Be alert to continually changing weather, visibility and surface conditions and other inherent risks including but not limited to: existing and changing surface or sub-surface snow and ice conditions, dirt, grass, bare spots, forest growth, trees, rocks, stumps, and other natural objects and collisions with or falls resulting from such natural objects, lift towers and components thereof, lights, signs, posts, fences, mazes or enclosures, hydrants, water or air pipes (all the foregoing whether above or below the snow surface), snowmaking and snow grooming equipment, marked or lighted trail maintenance vehicles and snowmobiles, other man-made structures or objects and their components, and collisions with or falls resulting from such man-made objects; variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or as a result of slope design; snowmaking or snow grooming operations, including but not limited to ski jumps, roads and catwalks or other man-made or natural terrain modifications and features including Freestyle Terrain; the presence of and collisions with other skiers and riders and the failure of others to ski and ride safely, in control or within their own ability.

I, the undersigned, hereby express my desire and approval for myself or my child's participation in the Learning Center Program. I acknowledge that such participation will include, without limitation, participation in various types of snow-sports instruction and activities and the use of Gunstock equipment, as well as the slopes, trails, Freestyle Terrain and related facilities, including ski lifts. I further acknowledge that participation in the program is voluntary and entirely at my risk and/or that of my child. I understand that recreational and other activities involve inherent and other risks of **INJURY** and **DEATH**. I agree that having a resort employee present does not lessen the amount or severity of the risks or hazards of these activities. I assume all risk of personal injury or loss of property as defined in **RSA 225A:24 (Responsibility of Skiers and Passengers)**.

I acknowledge that my child's involvement may include skiing, snowboarding, the use of Freestyle Terrain, lifts and participation in other recreational activities, and that these activities are **HAZARDOUS** and myself or my child have made a voluntary choice to participate in these activities despite the risks. **I hereby promise not to bring a claim against or sue, and AGREE TO RELEASE** Gunstock Area, Gunstock Area Commission, the County of Belknap, their shops, employees, owners, affiliates, agents, landowners, officers, directors, and their successors in interest, any equipment manufacturers and distributors, (collectively "Releases"), **from all liability for injury, death, property loss and/or damage that results from participation in recreational activities, that is in any way related to participation in the Learning Ctr. Program, the use of the equipment, or is related to any other activity at Gunstock including all liability that results from the NEGLIGENCE OF Releases, or any other person or cause.**

I further agree to **DEFEND, INDEMNIFY and HOLD HARMLESS** Releases for any loss or damage arising from claims or lawsuits related in any way to myself or my child's participation in the program, use of the equipment, or any other activities on Releases' premises. I understand that permission to use Releases premises, and myself or my child's involvement in this program is being given in exchange for the execution of this Release of Liability. I authorize Releases to administer first aid as they deem necessary. I authorize transportation to a medical facility, at my expense, if deemed necessary by Releases. Further, in the case of serious illness or injury, if I cannot be reached, I give permission for treatment, including medical and/or surgical care necessary for the well-being of myself or my child, at my expense. I agree that upon transporting my child, to any medical facility, clinic or hospital, that the responsibility of the Releases shall be totally fulfilled and the Releases shall have no further responsibility. I understand that Releases will, to the best of their ability, attempt to notify me as soon as possible in the event of an emergency.

I acknowledge that Gunstock will set the visual indicator settings on mine or the minor's skis in accordance to the manufacturer's specifications and the height, weight, shoe size, age, skier type, experience, head size and other information requested, I have provided on this form. **I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety.** In downhill skiing or ski boarding, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding and Telemark skiing (collectively **RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS**), the binding systems will **not** ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.

I understand that the sport of skiing, snowboarding and other **RECREATIONAL SNOWSPORTS** involve inherent and other risks of **INJURY and DEATH. I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death** that may result from skiing/snowboarding use, participation in this multi-week program, or which relate in any way to the use of the equipment to be issued to the user.

I understand that a helmet designed for **RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS** use will help reduce the risk of some types of injuries to the user at slower speeds. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.

**I AGREE TO RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS** the Gunstock ski/snowboard shop, its owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the manufacturers and distributors of the equipment and their successors in interest (collectively **PROVIDERS**) from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment users participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding, participation in this multi-week program, or is in any way related to the use of the equipment, including all liability that results from the **NEGLIGENCE OF PROVIDERS**, or any other person or cause.

Be alert to continually changing weather, visibility and surface conditions and other inherent risks including but not limited to: existing and changing surface or sub-surface snow and ice conditions, dirt, grass, bare spots, forest growth, trees, rocks, stumps, and other natural objects and collisions with or falls resulting from such natural objects, lift towers and components thereof, lights, signs, posts, fences, mazes or enclosures, hydrants, water or air pipes (all the foregoing whether above or below the snow surface), snowmaking and snow grooming equipment, marked or lighted trail maintenance vehicles and snowmobiles, other man-made structures or objects and their components, and collisions with or falls resulting from such man-made objects; variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or as a result of slope design; snowmaking or snow grooming operations, including but not limited to ski jumps, roads and catwalks or other man-made or natural terrain modifications and features including Freestyle Terrain; the presence of and collisions with other skiers and riders and the failure of others to ski and ride safely, in control or within their own ability.

I, the undersigned, hereby express my desire and approval for myself or my child's participation in the Learning Center Program. I acknowledge that such participation will include, without limitation, participation in various types of snow-sports instruction and activities and the use of Gunstock equipment, as well as the slopes, trails, Freestyle Terrain and related facilities, including ski lifts. 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
