Job Description Lifeguard (Temporary)**

Job Summary:

Responsible for supervising beaches and ensure the safety of all patrons while on duty. Applicant must be dependable, enjoy working with youth and families and have good communication skills. Reports to the Recreation Coordinator.

Essential Job Functions:

Recognize and respond quickly and effectively in emergencies.
Enforce all aquatic facility policies, rules and regulations.
Inspect the facility and report any unsafe conditions or equipment to the Recreation Coordinator.
Complete accident reports.
Complete additional duties as assigned by Recreation Coordinator

Minimum Qualifications:

Current certification in the following: American Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid.
American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer
Must submit and clear a federal background check and motor vehicle records check.

Licenses and Certifications:

Valid New Hampshire Driver's License, Certification in First Aid and Infant & Child and Adult CPR.
Red Cross Lifeguard Training.

Materials and Equipment Used:

Personal Automobile, Cell Phone, Rescue Equipment

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

Perform duties while swimming, standing, sitting, or walking, with reasonable accommodations if required.
Frequently lift light and occasionally heavy objects with assistant or reasonable accommodation if required.

Working Conditions:

The work is performed at an outdoor recreational facility. The incumbent may be exposed to cold or inclement weather, noise, dust, dirt, grease, contagious or infectious diseases, and irritating chemicals. Must be available to set flexible schedule to include nights and weekends
