Job Description- Water Safety Instructor (Temporary)

Job Summary: Applicants must be dependable, enjoy working with youth and families and have good communication skills.

Reports to the Recreation Coordinator.

Essential Job Function:

Teach swim lessons for a variety of levels and completing all necessary paperwork in a timely manner.

Thorough knowledge and application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques.

Recognize and respond quickly and effectively in emergencies.

Administers First Aid & CPR when necessary

Enforce all aquatic facility policies, rules and regulations.

Inspect the facility and report any unsafe conditions or equipment to the Recreation coordinator.

Complete accident reports.

Responsible for ensuring the safety of facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies.

Complete additional duties as assigned by Recreation Coordinator.

Minimum Qualifications:

All applicants have a current Red Cross Lifeguard Training, First Aid and Infant & Child and Adult CPR. Water Safety Instructor must have WSI Certification in addition to Lifeguard Training. Prior aquatic experience is desired. All applicants 18 years of age and older will be required to pass a criminal background check.

Licenses and Certifications:

Valid New Hampshire Driver's License, Certification in First Aid and Infant & Child And Adult CPR. Red Cross Lifeguard Training. All applicants 18 year of age and older required to pass a Criminal Background Check

Materials and Equipment Used:

Personal Automobile, Cell Phone, Rescue Equipment

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

Perform duties while swimming, standing, sitting, or walking, with reasonable accommodations if required.

Frequently lift light and occasionally heavy objects with assistant or reasonable accommodation if required.

Working Conditions:

The work is performed at an outdoor recreational facility. The incumbent may be exposed to cold or inclement weather, noise, dust, dirt, grease, contagious or infectious diseases, and irritating chemicals.


Must be available to set flexible schedule to include nights and weekends
